A BILL

To improve the operation of the Organ Procurement and
Transplantation Network.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Lost Opportunities to
5 Supply Transplantable Organs Act of 2020” or the
6 “LOST Organs Act of 2020”.

7 **SEC. 2. ORGAN PROCUREMENT AND TRANSPLANTATION**
8 **NETWORK.**

9 Section 372(b)(2) of the Public Health Service Act
10 (42 U.S.C. 274(b)(2)) is amended—

1 (1) in subparagraph (E), by inserting “and
2 practice” after “quality”;

3 (2) by moving subparagraphs (M) through (O)
4 2 ems to the left;

5 (3) by redesignating subparagraphs (H)
6 through (O) as subparagraphs (J) through (Q), re-
7 spectively; and

8 (4) by inserting after subparagraph (G) the fol-
9 lowing:

10 “(H) track and publicly report, with redactions
11 of personal identifiers of donors, waitlist candidates,
12 and recipients, on the status of all organs in trans-
13 port from organ procurement organizations to any
14 location within the transplant supply chain, includ-
15 ing transplant centers,

16 “(I) in the event that an organ is lost, dam-
17 aged, or delayed in transport, establish an open and
18 transparent process to determine cause, corrective
19 action, and recommendations for updates to the
20 standards of quality and practice under subpara-
21 graph (E) to prevent organs from being lost, dam-
22 aged, or delayed.”.
