A BILL

To amend section 353 of the Public Health Service Act with respect to suspension, revocation, and limitation of laboratory certification.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Taking Essential Steps
5 for Testing Act” or the “TEST Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. SUSPENSION, REVOCATION, AND LIMITATION OF**
2 **LABORATORY CERTIFICATION.**

3 Section 353 of the Public Health Service Act (42
4 U.S.C. 263a) is amended—

5 (1) in subsection (d)(1)(E), by inserting “, ex-
6 cept that no proficiency testing sample shall be re-
7 ferred to another laboratory for analysis as prohib-
8 ited under subsection (i)(4)” before the period at the
9 end; and

10 (2) in subsection (i)—

11 (A) in paragraph (3), by inserting before
12 the period at the end of the first sentence the
13 following: “, except that if the revocation occurs
14 pursuant to paragraph (4) the Secretary may
15 substitute intermediate sanctions under sub-
16 section (h) instead of the 2-year prohibition
17 against ownership or operation which would
18 otherwise apply under this paragraph”; and

19 (B) in paragraph (4), by striking “shall”
20 the first place it appears and inserting “may”.
