## A BILL

To provide a 77-day extension of certain authorities for foreign intelligence and international terrorism investigations, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SEVENTY-SEVEN-DAY EXTENSION OF AUTHOR-**  
4 **ITY TO ACCESS CERTAIN BUSINESS RECORDS**  
5 **FOR FOREIGN INTELLIGENCE AND INTER-**  
6 **NATIONAL TERRORISM INVESTIGATIONS AND**  
7 **FOR ROVING SURVEILLANCE.**

8 Section 102(b)(1) of the USA PATRIOT Improve-  
9 ment and Reauthorization Act of 2005 (Public Law 109–

1 177; 50 U.S.C. 1805 note) is amended by striking “March  
2 15, 2020” and inserting “May 30, 2020”.

3 **SEC. 2. SEVENTY-SEVEN-DAY EXTENSION OF AUTHORITY**  
4 **FOR INDIVIDUAL TERRORISTS TO BE TREAT-**  
5 **ED AS AGENTS OF FOREIGN POWERS UNDER**  
6 **THE FOREIGN INTELLIGENCE SURVEIL-**  
7 **LANCE ACT OF 1978.**

8 Section 6001(b)(1) of the Intelligence Reform and  
9 Terrorism Prevention Act of 2004 (Public Law 108–458;  
10 50 U.S.C. 1801 note) is amended by striking “March 15,  
11 2020” and inserting “May 30, 2020”.

12 **SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

13 This Act and the amendments made by this Act take  
14 effect on March 14, 2020.
