A BILL

To appropriate, with an offset, \$36,000,000 for the Seafood Import Monitoring Program of the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration to increase audits of imported shrimp and red snapper.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. INCREASED AUDITS OF IMPORTED SHRIMP**
4 **AND RED SNAPPER BY SEAFOOD IMPORT**
5 **MONITORING PROGRAM.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—There are appropriated, out of
7 any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated,
8 \$36,000,000 to the Administrator of the National Oceanic

1 and Atmospheric Administration for fiscal year 2024 for
2 the Seafood Import Monitoring Program to increase au-
3 dits of imported shrimp and red snapper.

4 (b) OFFSET.—Of the balances of amounts appro-
5 priated or otherwise made available for activities of the
6 Internal Revenue Service by paragraphs (1)(A)(ii),
7 (1)(A)(iii), (1)(B), (2), (3), (4), and (5) of section 10301
8 of Public Law 117–169 (commonly known as the “Infla-
9 tion Reduction Act of 2022”) that are available for obliga-
10 tion as of the date of the enactment of this Act,
11 \$36,000,000 are hereby rescinded.
