### **AN ACT**

- To provide relief for the recipients of financial assistance awards from the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration, and for other purposes.
  - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
  - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

#### 1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "Motor Carrier Safety3 Grant Relief Act of 2020".

## 4 SEC. 2. RELIEF FOR RECIPIENTS OF FINANCIAL ASSIST5 ANCE AWARDS FROM THE FEDERAL MOTOR 6 CARRIER SAFETY ADMINISTRATION.

7 (a) DEFINITION OF SECRETARY.—In this section, the
8 term "Secretary" means the Secretary of Transportation.
9 (b) RELIEF FOR RECIPIENTS OF FINANCIAL ASSIST10 ANCE AWARDED FOR FISCAL YEARS 2019 AND 2020.—

11 (1) PERIOD OF AVAILABILITY.—

12 (A) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any 13 provision of chapter 311 of title 49, United 14 States Code (including any applicable period of 15 availability under section 31104(f) of that title), 16 and any regulations promulgated under that 17 chapter and subject to subparagraph (B), the 18 period of availability during which a recipient 19 may expend amounts made available to the re-20 cipient under a grant or cooperative agreement 21 described in clauses (i) through (v) shall be—

(i) for a grant made under section
31102 of that title (other than subsection
(l) of that section)—

25 (I) the fiscal year in which the26 Secretary approves the financial as-

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1	sistance agreement with respect to the
2	grant; and
3	(II) the following 2 fiscal years;
4	(ii) for a grant made or a cooperative
5	agreement entered into under section
6	31102(l)(2) of that title—
7	(I) the fiscal year in which the
8	Secretary approves the financial as-
9	sistance agreement with respect to the
10	grant or cooperative agreement; and
11	(II) the following 3 fiscal years;
12	(iii) for a grant made under section
13	31102(l)(3) of that title—
14	(I) the fiscal year in which the
15	Secretary approves the financial as-
16	sistance agreement with respect to the
17	grant; and
18	(II) the following 5 fiscal years;
19	(iv) for a grant made under section
20	31103 of that title—
21	(I) the fiscal year in which the
22	Secretary approves the financial as-
23	sistance agreement with respect to the
24	grant; and

1	(II) the following 2 fiscal years;
2	and
3	(v) for a grant made or a cooperative
4	agreement entered into under section
5	31313 of that title—
6	(I) the year in which the Sec-
7	retary approves the financial assist-
8	ance agreement with respect to the
9	grant or cooperative agreement; and
10	(II) the following 5 fiscal years.
11	(B) Applicability.—
12	(i) Amounts awarded for fiscal
13	YEARS 2019 AND 2020.—The periods of
14	availability described in subparagraph (A)
15	shall apply only—
16	(I) to amounts awarded for fiscal
17	year 2019 or 2020 under a grant or
18	cooperative agreement described in
19	clauses (i) through (v) of that sub-
20	paragraph; and
21	(II) for the purpose of expanding
22	the period of availability during which
23	the recipient may expend the amounts
24	described in subclause (I).

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1 (ii) Amounts awarded for other YEARS.—The periods of availability de-2 3 scribed in subparagraph (A) shall not 4 apply to any amounts awarded under a 5 grant or cooperative agreement described 6 in clauses (i) through (v) of that subpara-7 graph for any fiscal year other than fiscal 8 year 2019 or 2020, and those amounts 9 shall be subject to the period of availability 10 otherwise applicable to those amounts under Federal law. 11 12 (2) REALLOCATION OF RELEASED FUNDS. 13 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any

amounts released back to the Secretary under section 31104(i) of title 49, United States Code, that
were made available to the Secretary under section
31104(a) of that title for fiscal year 2019 or 2020
shall not be subject to any limitation on obligations
under Federal law.
