**A BILL**

To require Senate candidates to file designations, statements,

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2       This Act may be cited as the “Senate Campaign Dis-  
3 closure Parity Act”.

4 **SEC. 2. FILING BY SENATE CANDIDATES WITH COMMIS-**  
5 **SION.**

6       Section 302(g) of the Federal Election Campaign Act  
7 of 1971 (2 U.S.C. 432(g)) is amended to read as follows:

8           “(g) FILING WITH THE COMMISSION.—All des-  
9 ignations, statements, and reports required to be  
10 filed under this Act shall be filed with the Commis-  
11 sion.”.
