Mr. DAINES introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Finance

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## A BILL

To require States to pass-through 45 percent of the amounts paid from the Coronavirus Relief Fund to local governments that did not receive a direct payment from the Fund.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Strengthening Local  
5 Coronavirus Response Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PASS-THROUGH OF PORTION OF STATE CORONAVI-**  
2 **RUS RELIEF FUND TO LOCAL GOVERNMENTS.**

3 (a) **PASS-THROUGH REQUIREMENT.**—Subsection (b)  
4 of section 601 of the Social Security Act, as added by sec-  
5 tion 5001(a) of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic  
6 Security Act (Public Law 116–136) is amended—

7 (1) in paragraph (1), by striking “Subject to  
8 paragraph (2)” and inserting “Subject to para-  
9 graphs (2) and (3)”; and

10 (2) by adding at the end the following

11 “(3) **PASS-THROUGH REQUIREMENT.**—Each  
12 State shall distribute 45 percent of the amount paid  
13 to the State under this section for fiscal year 2020  
14 (after the application of paragraph (2)) upon receipt  
15 on a pass-through basis, and without requiring any  
16 application, to each unit of local government in the  
17 State that is not a large unit of local government  
18 that received a direct payment under this section in  
19 accordance with paragraph (2). The preceding dis-  
20 tribution requirement shall not apply to the District  
21 of Columbia.”.

22 (b) **CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.**—Section 601 of  
23 such Act is further amended—

24 (1) in subsection (b)—

1 (A) in paragraphs (1) and (2), by inserting  
 2 “large” before “unit of local government” each  
 3 place it appears; and

4 (B) in paragraph (2)—

5 (i) in the paragraph heading, by in-  
 6 serting “LARGE” before “UNITS”; and

7 (ii) by adding at the end the fol-  
 8 lowing: “For purposes of this section, the  
 9 term ‘large unit of local government’  
 10 means a unit of local government, as de-  
 11 fined in subsection (g)(2), with a popu-  
 12 lation that exceeds 500,000.”;

13 (2) in subsection (c)(5)—

14 (A) in the paragraph heading, by inserting  
 15 “LARGE” before “UNIT”; and

16 (B) by inserting “large” before “unit of  
 17 local government” each place it appears;

18 (3) in subsection (e)—

19 (A) by inserting “direct” before “pay-  
 20 ment”; and

21 (B) by inserting “large” before “unit of  
 22 local government” each place it appears; and

23 (4) in subsection (g)(2)—

24 (A) in the paragraph heading, by striking  
 25 “LOCAL” and inserting “UNIT OF LOCAL”; and

1                   (B) by striking “with a population that ex-  
2                   ceeds 500,000.”

3           (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by  
4 this section shall take effect as if included in the enact-  
5 ment of section 601 of the Social Security Act, as added  
6 by section 5001(a) of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and  
7 Economic Security Act (Public Law 116–136).

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
