3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Military Spouse Job
5 Continuity Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PERMANENT AUTHORITY TO REIMBURSE A MEM-**
2 **BER OF THE UNIFORMED SERVICES FOR**
3 **SPOUSE RELICENSING AND BUSINESS COSTS**
4 **FOLLOWING MEMBER'S RELOCATION.**

5 Section 453(g) of title 37, United States Code, is
6 amended—

7 (1) by striking paragraph (3); and

8 (2) by redesignating paragraphs (4) and (5) as
9 paragraphs (3) and (4), respectively.
