A BILL

To reaffirm the applicability of the Indian Reorganization Act to the Lytton Rancheria of California, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. LYTTON RANCHERIA OF CALIFORNIA LAND RE-**
4 **AFFIRMATION.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
6 sion of law, the Lytton Rancheria of California is subject
7 to the Act of June 18, 1934 (commonly known as the “In-
8 dian Reorganization Act”) (48 Stat. 984, chapter 576; 25
9 U.S.C. 5101 et seq.), and the Secretary of the Interior
10 may acquire and take into trust land for the benefit of

1 the Lytton Rancheria of California pursuant to section 5
2 of that Act (25 U.S.C. 5108).

3 (b) LAND TO BE MADE PART OF THE RESERVA-
4 TION.—Land taken into trust pursuant to subsection (a)
5 shall be—

6 (1) part of the reservation of the Lytton
7 Rancheria of California; and

8 (2) administered in accordance with the laws
9 and regulations generally applicable to property held
10 in trust by the United States for an Indian Tribe.
