A BILL

To designate the community-based outpatient clinic of the Department of Veterans Affairs, located at 400 College Drive, Middleburg, Florida, the “Andrew K. Baker Department of Veterans Affairs Clinic”, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF ANDREW K. BAKER DEPART-**
4 **MENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS CLINIC.**

5 (a) DESIGNATION.—The community-based outpatient
6 clinic of the Department of Veterans Affairs, located at
7 400 College Drive, Middleburg, Florida, shall after the

1 date of the enactment of this Act be known and designated
2 as “Andrew K. Baker Department of Veterans Affairs
3 Clinic” or the “A.K. Baker V.A. Clinic”.

4 (b) REFERENCE.—Any reference in any law, regula-
5 tion, map, document, record, or other paper of the United
6 States to the community-based outpatient clinic referred
7 to in subsection (a) shall be considered to be a reference
8 to the Andrew K. Baker Department of Veterans Affairs
9 Clinic.

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
