A BILL

To provide that individuals may serve as poll workers for the November 3, 2020, general election if registered to vote in the State in a location other than the location at which the individual serves.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Poll Worker Recruit-
5 ment Act of 2020”.

1 **SEC. 2. SPECIAL RULES FOR POLL WORKER REGISTRATION**
2 **REQUIREMENTS FOR THE 2020 GENERAL**
3 **ELECTION.**

4 A State or local jurisdiction may not prohibit an indi-
5 vidual from serving as a poll worker in the general election
6 for Federal office occurring on November 3, 2020, solely
7 because such individual is registered to vote in the State
8 in a county or jurisdiction other than the county or juris-
9 diction in which such individual serves as a poll worker
10 in such election.

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
