 - 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
 - 4 This Act may be cited as the "Santa Susana Fair
 - 5 Compensation Act".
 - 6 SEC. 2. DEFINITION OF MEMBER OF SPECIAL EXPOSURE
 - 7 COHORT.
 - 8 (a) In General.—Section 3621(14) of the Energy
- 9 Employees Occupational Illness Compensation Program

- 1 Act of 2000 (42 U.S.C. 7384l(14)) is amended by adding
- 2 at the end the following new subparagraph:
- 3 "(D) The employee was so employed for a
- 4 number of work days aggregating at least 250
- 5 work days before January 1, 2009, by the De-
- 6 partment of Energy or a Department of Energy
- 7 contractor or subcontractor at the Santa
- 8 Susana Field Laboratory in California.".
- 9 (b) Reapplication.—A claim that an individual
- 10 qualifies, by reason of section 3621(14)(D) of the Energy
- 11 Employees Occupational Illness Compensation Program
- 12 Act of 2000 (as added by subsection (a)), for compensa-
- 13 tion or benefits under such Act shall be considered for
- 14 compensation or benefits notwithstanding any denial of
- 15 any other claim for compensation with respect to such in-
- 16 dividual.
