SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- This Act may be cited as the "Moving Americans Pri-
- 3 vacy Protection Act".
- 4 SEC. 2. PROTECTION OF PERSONALLY IDENTIFIABLE IN-
- 5 FORMATION.
- 6 (a) In General.—Paragraph (2) of section 431(c)
- 7 of the Tariff Act of 1930 (19 U.S.C. 1431(c)) is amended
- 8 to read as follows:
- 9 "(2)(A) The information listed in paragraph (1) shall
- 10 not be available for public disclosure if—
- 11 "(i) the Secretary of the Treasury makes an af-
- firmative finding on a shipment-by-shipment basis
- that disclosure is likely to pose a threat of personal
- injury or property damage; or
- 15 "(ii) the information is exempt under the provi-
- sions of section 552(b)(1) of title 5, United States
- 17 Code.
- 18 "(B) The Secretary shall ensure that any personally
- 19 identifiable information, including Social Security num-
- 20 bers and passport numbers, is removed from any manifest
- 21 signed, produced, delivered, or electronically transmitted
- 22 under this section before access to the manifest is provided
- 23 to the public.".

- 1 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 2 subsection (a) shall take effect on the date that is 30 days
- 3 after the date of the enactment of this Act.
