Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. APPOINTMENT AND GRADE OF CHIEF OF THE

ARMY MEDICAL SPECIALIST CORPS.

Section 3070(b) of title 10, United States Code, is
amended—

(1) in the first sentence, by striking "captain"
and inserting "lieutenant colonel"; and
(2) by inserting after the first sentence the fol-

lowing new sentence: "An appointee who holds a

- 1 lower regular grade shall be appointed in the regular
- 2 grade of brigadier general.".
