## A BILL

To establish a 90-day limit to file a petition for judicial review of a permit, license, or approval for a highway or public transportation project, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “90-Day Review Act”.

5 **SEC. 2. LIMITATIONS ON CLAIMS.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 139(l) of title 23, United  
7 States Code, is amended by striking “150 days” each  
8 place it appears and inserting “90 days”.

9 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—

1           (1) Section 330(e) of title 23, United States  
2 Code, is amended—

3           (A) in paragraph (2)(A), by striking “150  
4 days” and inserting “90 days”; and

5           (B) in paragraph (3)(B)(i), by striking  
6 “150 days” and inserting “90 days”.

7           (2) Section 24201(a)(4) of title 49, United  
8 States Code, is amended by striking “of 150 days”.
