A BILL

To limit the establishment or extension of national monuments in the State of Utah.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Protect Utah's Rural
- 5 Economy Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OR EXTEN-
- 7 SION OF NATIONAL MONUMENTS IN THE
- 8 STATE OF UTAH.
- 9 Section 320301 of title 54, United States Code, is
- 10 amended by adding at the end the following:

1	"(e) Limitation on the Establishment or Ex-
2	TENSION OF NATIONAL MONUMENTS IN THE STATE OF
3	UTAH.—Notwithstanding any other provision of this sec-
4	tion, the President may not establish or extend a national
5	monument in the State of Utah (referred to in this sub-
6	section as the 'State') unless—
7	"(1) the extension or establishment has been
8	authorized by an Act of Congress; and
9	"(2) the President has received from the Gov-
10	ernor of the State notice that the State legislature
11	has enacted legislation approving the proposed es-
12	tablishment or extension.".
