A BILL

To amend the Omnibus Public Land Management Act of 2009 to make a technical correction to the water rights settlement for the Shoshone-Paiute Tribes of the Duck Valley Reservation, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Technical Correction
5 to the Shoshone-Paiute Tribes of the Duck Valley Res-
6 ervation Water Rights Settlement Act of 2023”.

1 **SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION OF PAYMENT OF ADJUSTED IN-**
2 **TEREST ON DEVELOPMENT FUND.**

3 Section 10807(b)(3) of the Omnibus Public Land
4 Management Act of 2009 (Public Law 111–11; 123 Stat.
5 1409) is amended—

6 (1) by striking “There is” and inserting the fol-
7 lowing:

8 “(A) IN GENERAL.—There is”; and

9 (2) by adding at the end the following:

10 “(B) ADJUSTED INTEREST PAYMENTS.—

11 “(i) IN GENERAL.—There is author-
12 ized to be appropriated to the Secretary
13 for deposit into the Development Fund
14 \$5,124,902.12.

15 “(ii) COST INDEXING.—All amounts
16 made available to carry out clause (i) shall,
17 on deposit into the Development Fund, be
18 adjusted to reflect changes since January
19 25, 2016, in the Consumer Price Index for
20 All Urban Consumers West Urban 50,000
21 to 1,500,000 published by the Bureau of
22 Labor Statistics.”.
