JOINT RESOLUTION

Providing for congressional disapproval of the proposed foreign military sale to the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia certain defense articles and services.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the following proposed foreign military sale to the
4 Kingdom of Saudi Arabia is prohibited:

5 (1) The sale of the following defense articles,
6 including defense services and technical data, de-
7 scribed in Transmittal No. 18–21, submitted to Con-
8 gress pursuant to section 36(b) of the Arms Export
9 Control Act (22 U.S.C. 2776(b)) and published in

1 the Congressional Record on June 4, 2019: The pro-
2 posed sale of follow-on support and services for
3 Royal Saudi Air Force aircraft, engines, and weap-
4 ons; publications and technical documentation; sup-
5 port equipment; spare and repair parts; repair and
6 return; calibration support and test equipment; per-
7 sonnel equipment; United States Government and
8 contractor technical and logistics support; and other
9 related elements of program support.
