
JOINT RESOLUTION

Providing for congressional disapproval of the proposed foreign military sale to the United Arab Emirates of certain defense articles and services.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the following proposed foreign military sale to the
4 United Arab Emirates is prohibited:

5 (1) The sale of the following defense articles,
6 including defense services and technical data, de-
7 scribed in Transmittal No. 17-0B, submitted to
8 Congress pursuant to section 36(b) of the Arms Ex-
9 port Control Act (22 U.S.C. 2776(b)) and published
10 in the Congressional Record on June 4, 2019: The
11 proposed sale of 28 AH-64E Remanufactured
12 Apache Attack Helicopters; 10 new AH-64E Apache
13 Attack Helicopters; 76 T700-GE-701D Engines (56
14 remanufactured, 18 new, 6 spares, 2 installed); 40
15 AN/ASQ-170 Modernized Target Acquisition and
16 Designation Sight/AN/AAR-11 Modernized Pilot

1 Night Vision Sensors (28 remanufactured, 10 new,
2 2 spares); 32 remanufactured AN/APR-48B Mod-
3 ernized Radar Frequency Interferometers; 47 AAR-
4 57 Common Missile Warning Systems (31 remanu-
5 factured, 10 new, 6 spares); 150 Embedded Global
6 Positioning Systems with Inertial Navigation (60 re-
7 manufactured, 74 new, 16 spares); 45 Manned-Un-
8 manned Teaming-International (MUMTi) systems
9 (28 remanufactured, 10 new, 7 spares); and 15 new
10 MUMTi System Upper Receivers, training devices,
11 helmets, simulators, generators, transportation,
12 wheeled vehicles and organization equipment, spare
13 and repair parts, support equipment, tools and test
14 equipment, technical data and publications, per-
15 sonnel training and training equipment, United
16 States Government and contractor engineering, tech-
17 nical, and logistics support services, and other re-
18 lated elements of logistics support.
