RESOLUTION

To authorize production of documents to the Department
of Defense Inspector General

Whereas last Congress the Committee on Armed Services
conducted a staff inquiry into allegations regarding irreg-
ularities in the administration of a contract for logistical
support in Iraq by the Department of the Army;

Whereas, upon the completion of the Committee's staff in-
quiry, the Chairman and ranking member referred to the
Acting Inspector General of the Department of Defense
for review allegations regarding the Administration of
this LOGCAP contract;

Whereas, by the privileges of the Senate of the United States
and rule XI of the Standing Rules of the Senate, no evi-
dence under the control or in the possession of the Sen-
ate may, by the judicial or administrative process, be

taken from such control or possession but by permission of the Senate; and

Whereas, when it appears that evidence under the control or in the possession of the Senate may promote the administration of justice, the Senate will take such action as will promote the ends of justice consistent with the privileges of the Senate: Now, therefore, be it

1 *Resolved*, That the Chairman and ranking member of
2 the Armed Services Committee, acting jointly, are author-
3 ized to produce to the Department of Defense Inspector
4 General records of the Committee's staff inquiry into alle-
5 gations relating to the administration of the Army's
6 LOGCAP contract.
