RESOLUTION

Expressing the sense of the Senate that the United States Postal Service should issue a semipostal stamp to support medical research relating to Alzheimer's disease.

1 *Resolved*, That it is the sense of the Senate that the
2 United States Postal Service should, in accordance with
3 section 416 of title 39, United States Code—

4 (1) issue a semipostal stamp to support medical
5 research relating to Alzheimer's disease; and

6 (2) transfer to the National Institutes of Health
7 for that purpose any amounts becoming available
8 from the sale of such stamp.
