Authorizing expenditures by the Committee on Rules and Administration.

Mr. SCHUMER, from the Committee on Rules and Administration, reported the following original resolution; which was placed on the calendar

RESOLUTION

Authorizing expenditures by the Committee on Rules and Administration.

1 *Resolved*, That, in carrying out its powers, duties, and
2 functions under the Standing Rules of the Senate, in ac-
3 cordance with its jurisdiction under rule XXV of such
4 rules, including holding hearings, reporting such hearings,
5 and making investigations as authorized by paragraphs 1
6 and 8 of rule XXVI of the Standing Rules of the Senate,
7 the Committee on Rules and Administration is authorized
8 from March 1, 2013, through September 30, 2013, in its
9 discretion (1) to make expenditures from the contingent

1 fund of the Senate, (2) to employ personnel, and (3) with
2 the prior consent of the Government department or agency
3 concerned and the Committee on Rules and Administra-
4 tion, to use on a reimbursable or non-reimbursable basis
5 the services of personnel of any such department or agen-
6 cy.

7 SEC. 2. The expenses of the committee for the period
8 March 1, 2013, through September 30, 2013, under this
9 resolution shall not exceed \$1,619,831, of which amount
10 (1) not to exceed \$43,750 may be expended for the pro-
11 curement of the services of individual consultants, or orga-
12 nizations thereof (as authorized by section 202(i) of the
13 Legislative Reorganization Act of 1946, as amended), and
14 (2) not to exceed \$7,000 may be expended for the training
15 of the professional staff of such committee (under proce-
16 dures specified by section 202(j) of the Legislative Reorga-
17 nization Act of 1946).

18 SEC. 3. Expenses of the committee under this resolu-
19 tion shall be paid from the contingent fund of the Senate
20 upon vouchers approved by the chairman of the com-
21 mittee, except that vouchers shall not be required (1) for
22 the disbursement of salaries of employees paid at an an-
23 nual rate, or (2) for the payment of telecommunications
24 provided by the Office of the Sergeant at Arms and Door-
25 keeper, United States Senate, or (3) for the payment of

1 stationery supplies purchased through the Keeper of the
2 Stationery, United States Senate, or (4) for payments to
3 the Postmaster, United States Senate, or (5) for the pay-
4 ment of metered charges on copying equipment provided
5 by the Office of the Sergeant at Arms and Doorkeeper,
6 United States Senate, or (6) for the payment of Senate
7 Recording and Photographic Services, or (7) for payment
8 of franked and mass mail costs by the Sergeant at Arms
9 and Doorkeeper, United States Senate.

10 SEC. 4. There are authorized such sums as may be
11 necessary for agency contributions related to the com-
12 pensation of employees of the committee from March 1,
13 2013, through September 30, 2013, to be paid from the
14 Appropriations account for “Expenses of Inquiries and In-
15 vestigations”.

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
