Section 58-28-607 is enacted to read: 25 58-28-607. Construction of chapter as it relates to teeth floating. 26 (1) As used in this section, "teeth floating" means the removal by a non-veterinary

27 equine dental care provider of enamel points and the smoothing, contouring, or leveling of

- 28 dental arcades and incisors of equine or other farm animals, excluding a canine or feline.
- 29 (2) Nothing in this chapter may be construed to prohibit teeth floating.
