Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to set the compensation levels for the Governor and the heads of departments and agencies at the same level as members of the General Assembly, other than the Speaker of the House and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate.

An act relating to compensation for the Governor and the heads of departments and agencies

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
Sec. 1. 32 V.S.A. § 1003 is amended to read:
§ 1003. STATE OFFICERS
(a) Each elective officer of the Executive Department, other than the

Governor, is entitled to an annual salary as follows:

(b)(1) The Governor may appeint and each officer of the Executive Branch listed in this subsection at a starting salary ranging from the base salary stated for that position to a salary that does not exceed the maximum salary unless etherwise authorized by this subsection. The maximmm salary for each appointive officer shall be 50 percent above the base salary. Anntally, the Governor may grant to each of these officers an annual salary adjustment subject to the maximum salary. The annwal salary adjustment granted to efficers under this subsection shall not exceed the average rate of adjustment available to classified employees under the collective bargaining agreement then in effect. In addition to the anmal salary adjustment specified in this subsection, the Governor may grant a special salary inerease subject to the maximum salary, or a bonms, to any officer listed in this subsection whose job duties have significantly increased, or whose contributions to the State in the preceding year are deemed especially significant. Special salary increases or bonuses granted to any individual shall not exceed the average rate of adjustment available to classified employees under the collective bargaining
