## SENATE BILL 6102

1 AN ACT Relating to establishing minimum in-state resident 2 enrollment thresholds for public universities; adding a new section 3 to chapter 28B.10 RCW; and creating a new section.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 Sec. 1. The legislature finds that ensuring NEW SECTION. 6 Washington residents have access to high quality postsecondary 7 degrees and credentials is imperative to the success and opportunity of those individuals in the state's diverse and growing economy. 8 Further, the legislature finds that the foremost role of Washington's 9 10 public higher education institutions, has been from inception, and 11 continues to be, to provide access to qualified Washington residents 12 to such education. It is therefore the intent of this act to guarantee that Washington institutions of higher education prioritize 13 14 Washington resident students for enrollment in postsecondary 15 education programs.

16 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 28B.10 17 RCW to read as follows:

(1) The fall freshman head count enrollment at each of the state universities, regional universities, the state college, and separately, their respective university campuses must annually equal 1 at least 75 percent Washington resident students. If insufficient 2 academically qualified resident undergraduate applicants apply, an 3 institution may enroll additional nonresident applicants such that 4 the resident student enrollment mix is less than 75 percent.

5 (2) Unless the context clearly requires otherwise, the 6 definitions in this subsection apply throughout this section:

7 (a) "Academically qualified" means the applicant meets the8 institution's published minimum admissions standards.

9 (b) "Resident student" has the same meaning as in RCW 28B.15.012.

10 (c) "University campuses" are those provided in chapter 28B.45
11 RCW.

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
