Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill makes changes to the apprenticeship and youth apprenticeship completion awards, career and technical education incentive grants and completion awards, technical preparation programs in school districts and technical colleges, creating an individual income tax credit for completing an apprenticeship program, rejection criteria for part-time open enrollment applications, extending the time limit for emergency rule procedures, and providing an exemption from emergency rule procedures.

This fiscal estimate is limited to those bill provisions related to programs administered or funded by DPI.

Fiscal estimate of the part-time open enrollment provisions in the bill:

State impact: None.

Under open enrollment, payments for students who open enroll into a non-resident school district happen via transfer of aid between school districts. The state does not incur additional costs related to open enrollment.

Local impact: indeterminate.

The impact of this bill on school districts will depend on the number of pupils who open enroll in each school districts.
