# **2023 ASSEMBLY BILL 1047**

February 2, 2024 - Introduced by Representatives SHELTON, SNODGRASS, J. ANDERSON, BARE, CONLEY, CONSIDINE, EMERSON, HONG, JACOBSON, JOERS, MADISON, MOORE OMOKUNDE, NEUBAUER, OHNSTAD, ORTIZ-VELEZ, PALMERI, RATCLIFF, SINICKI, STUBBS, SUBECK, ANDRACA and HAYWOOD, cosponsored by Senators SMITH, SPREITZER, AGARD, CARPENTER, L. JOHNSON, ROYS, TAYLOR and LARSON. Referred to Committee on Campaigns and Elections.

AN ACT to create 5.05 (11r) and 20.510 (1) (ff) of the statutes; relating to: grants 1  $\mathbf{2}$ for the purchase of election supplies and equipment and making an 3 appropriation.

#### Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill authorizes the Elections Commission to award grants to municipalities for the purchase of election supplies and equipment, including electronic poll books. Under the bill, a municipality must apply for a grant no later than 180 days before a general election and agree to have the commission conduct at least one random inspection of the supplies and equipment that the municipality purchases with the grant moneys. Finally, the bill requires the commission to conduct an audit of the grant program no later than 90 days after each general election and submit an audit report to the legislature.

- **SECTION 1.** 5.05 (11r) of the statutes is created to read: 4
