## 2015 ASSEMBLY BILL 148

AN ACT to create 118.60 (7) (h), 118.60 (7) (i), 118.60 (10) (a) 9., 119.23 (7) (h), 119.23 (7) (i) and 119.23 (10) (a) 9. of the statutes; relating to: requiring a private school participating in a parental choice program to employ certain special education staff and to comply with certain provisions of the Americans with Disabilities Act.

#### Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires a private school participating in a parental choice program (PCP) that enrolls a child with a disability to employ a teacher or therapist who is licensed by DPI to provide special education or related services. The bill also requires a private school participating in a PCP to comply with Part A of Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act. Finally, DPI may prohibit a private school from participating in a PCP if the private school fails to satisfy these requirements.
