



2013 ASSEMBLY BILL 254

June 20, 2013 – Introduced by Representatives BROOKS, PETRYK, BERCEAU, RIPP, WRIGHT, CZAJA, MARKLEIN, BIES, OHNSTAD, BERNIER, A. OTT, WILLIAMS and LEMAHIEU, cosponsored by Senators SCHULTZ, HANSEN, HARRIS, T. CULLEN, L. TAYLOR and LASSA. Referred to Committee on Natural Resources and Sporting Heritage.

1 **AN ACT** *to amend* 27.01 (7) (c) 6., 27.01 (7) (c) 11., 27.01 (8) (b) 2. and 27.01 (8)
2 (bn) 1. of the statutes; **relating to:** free admission to state parks and state trails
3 for veterans.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, most vehicles entering state parks must display a vehicle admission receipt (sticker), either for annual use or for one-day use. Some vehicles are exempt from the sticker requirement, including a vehicle operated by a disabled veteran. Also under current law, the Department of Natural Resources may charge an admission fee to enter a state trail and disabled veterans are exempt from this fee as well. This bill extends both of these exemptions to all veterans discharged under conditions other than dishonorable.
