AUTHORS SUBJECT TO CHANGE

1 **AN ACT relating to:** grants for crisis intervention teams and making an
2 appropriation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill provides \$1,000,000 for the Department of Health Services to award grants to local governmental units for the staffing of law enforcement agencies with mental health crisis intervention teams. Under current law, DHS must award grants totalling \$250,000 in each fiscal biennium for mental health crisis intervention team training for law enforcement agencies and correctional officers.
