2009 WISCONSIN ACT 385

AN ACT *to repeal* 29.569 (2); and *to amend* 29.569 (1) of the statutes; **relating to:** hunting of deer during the open bow hunting season.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 29.569 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

29.569 (1) SPECIFICATION OF EFFECTIVE PERIODS; RESTRICTIONS. Unless an approval issued under this chapter is suspended or revoked or unless another section of

this chapter specifically provides otherwise, the approval is valid for the period or season specified on the face of the approval or on an attachment to the approval. In addition to any other restriction under this chapter, no license may be issued if that issuance is restricted under sub. (2) or (3).

SECTION 2. 29.569 (2) of the statutes is repealed.

* Section 991.11, WISCONSIN STATUTES 2007-08 : Effective date of acts. "Every act and every portion of an act enacted by the legislature over the governor's partial veto which does not expressly prescribe the time when it takes effect shall take effect on the day after its date of publication as designated" by the secretary of state [the date of publication may not be more than 10 working days after the date of enactment].
