



2019 SENATE BILL 356

August 22, 2019 - Introduced by Senators HANSEN, SMITH, BEWLEY, LARSON, RINGHAND, SCHACHTNER and L. TAYLOR, cosponsored by Representatives SHANKLAND, SKOWRONSKI, ANDERSON, BILLINGS, BOWEN, CABRERA, EMERSON, FIELDS, GRUSZYNSKI, HESSELBEIN, KOLSTE, NEUBAUER, SARGENT, SINICKI, STUBBS, SPREITZER, SUBECK, C. 1 **AN ACT relating to:** providing additional funding to the University of Wisconsin
2 System and making an appropriation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill provides additional funding to the University of Wisconsin System to offset the reduction in funding that results from the resident undergraduate tuition freeze included in the 2019 biennial budget act. The bill does so by increasing the appropriation to the UW System for general program operations by \$16,800,000 in fiscal year 2019-20 and by \$33,600,000 in fiscal year 2020-21.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1. Fiscal changes.**

4 (1) In the schedule under s. 20.005 (3) for the appropriation to the Board of
5 Regents of the University of Wisconsin System under s. 20.285 (1) (a), the dollar
6 amount for fiscal year 2019-20 is increased by \$16,800,000 and the dollar amount
7 for fiscal year 2020-21 is increased by \$33,600,000 to offset the reduction in funding
