3 employer notification program administered by the Department of
4 Transportation to noncommercial motor vehicle drivers.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the Department of Transportation (DOT) administers an employer notification program. The program permits an employer of a commercial motor vehicle driver to register the driver's name with DOT and to be informed by DOT whenever a traffic-related conviction, suspension, revocation, cancellation, disqualification, or out-of-service order is recorded on the person's driving record.

This bill extends the employer notification program to allow an employer to register an employee who does not operate a commercial motor vehicle if the employee's employment responsibilities include the operation of any motor vehicle.
