March 1, 2019 - Introduced by Senators Larson, Bewley, Carpenter, Johnson and Smith, cosponsored by Representatives Brostoff, Anderson, Bowen, Cabrera, Considine, Crowley, Emerson, Sargent, Shankland, Sinicki, C. Taylor, Vruwink and Zamarripa. Referred to Committee on Elections, Ethics and Rural Issues.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires any committee that receives campaign finance contributions of more than \$100, cumulatively, from an individual to report the name and address of the individual's principal place of employment and occupation, if any. Current law requires the committee to report the occupation of an individual contributor who makes contributions of more than \$200, cumulatively.
