2023 SENATE BILL 814

December 19, 2023 – Introduced by Senators Cowles and Nass, cosponsored by Representatives Goeben, Gustafson, Penterman, Rozar, Sapik and Sinicki. Referred to Committee on Agriculture and Tourism.

AUTHORS SUBJECT TO CHANGE

1 AN ACT to create 97.30 (2) (b) 1. e. of the statutes; relating to: license 2 requirement exemption for retail food establishments that sell or process cotton 3 candy.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, retail food establishments must obtain an annual license from the Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection or one of its agents. Current law exempts certain retail food establishments from the annual license requirement, including retail establishments that are primarily engaged in selling fresh fruits and vegetables, honey, cider, or maple syrup, and retail food establishments where popcorn is popped, if these retail food establishments are not required to obtain a license to sell or process other food.

This bill adds retail food establishments that sell or process cotton candy, if the retail food establishment is not required to obtain a license to sell or process any other food.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 97.30 (2) (b) 1. e. of the statutes is created to read:

1 97.30 (2) (b) 1. e. A retail food establishment where cotton candy is sold or 2 processed, if the retail food establishment is not required to obtain a license under 3 this section to sell or process any other food.
