1 **Relating to:** renewing Wisconsin’s land ethic and reviving our heritage as a leader
2 and pioneer in environmental policy and sustainability, with a focus on taking
3 action to integrate solutions to carbon pollution and climate change into the
4 activities and businesses of our fellow citizens.

5 Whereas, faith leaders around the world are publicly recognizing that
6 destructive climate change is happening, that climate change is caused by human
7 action, that the value of a healthy planet cannot and should not be measured strictly
8 monetarily, and that it is the responsibility and moral obligation of all of us to help
9 save the planet we are carelessly and systematically destroying; and
