Virtual education amendments.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to virtual education; modifying who may teach
2 virtual education courses; modifying where a full-time
3 virtual education student may be enrolled; and providing for
4 an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 21-2-202(a)(xxxi)(A) and
9 21-13-330(g)(intro) are amended to read:

11 **21-2-202. Duties of the state superintendent.**

12

13 (a) In addition to any other duties assigned by law,
14 the state superintendent shall:

15

1 (xxxi) By rule and regulation and in consultation
2 with the state board of education and the Wyoming professional
3 teaching standards board, provide guidance and oversight of
4 virtual education by:

5
6 (A) Establishing, approving, facilitating
7 and monitoring a state network of virtual education courses
8 that meet state standards for course content and delivery by
9 Wyoming certified teachers or postsecondary faculty who meet
10 the requirements of W.S. 21-7-303(b). The state
11 superintendent shall annually publish a course catalog
12 identifying the courses available and the tuition to be
13 assessed on a per course basis as established by the school
14 district instructing the course;

16 **21-13-330. Virtual education; program content;**
17 **agreements between districts authorized.**

18
19 (g) Pursuant to rule and regulation of the department,
20 a school district providing full-time virtual education for
21 any-a student, or a student's resident school district that
22 has entered into an agreement with another school district to
23 provide full-time virtual education for the student, shall:

2 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2019.
