A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to alcoholic beverages; authorizing the
2 sale of alcoholic and malt beverages off-premises by a
3 holder of a bar and grill liquor license pursuant to a
4 catering permit; and providing for an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 12-4-413(f) and 12-4-502(b) are
9 amended to read:

10

11 **12-4-413. Bar and grill liquor license; authorized;**
12 **requirements.**

14 (f) Bar and grill liquor licenses shall be subject to
15 the provisions of W.S. 12-4-408 and 12-4-410(c) to the same
16 extent those provisions are applicable to restaurant liquor

1 licenses. Bar and grill liquor licensees shall not sell
2 alcoholic or malt beverages for consumption off the
3 premises owned or leased by the licensee except as allowed
4 under W.S. 12-4-410(e) or pursuant to a catering permit as
5 provided in W.S. 12-4-502(b).

7 **12-4-502. Twenty-four hour malt beverage permit and**
8 **catering permit; restrictions; application procedure; fees.**

9

10 (b) A catering permit authorizing the sale of
11 alcoholic and malt beverages may be issued by the
12 appropriate licensing authority to any person holding a
13 retail, bar and grill or resort retail liquor license
14 authorizing the off-premises sale of both alcoholic and
15 malt beverages, for sales at meetings, conventions, private
16 parties and dinners or at other similar gatherings not
17 capable of being held within the licensee's licensed
18 premises. No licensee holding a catering permit shall sell
19 or permit consumption of any alcoholic or malt beverage off
20 the premises described in the permit. Notwithstanding any
21 other provision of this subsection, closed-container items
22 sold at auction for the benefit of a nonprofit organization
23 may be taken off-premises.

1 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2010.
