Campaign finance reporting-time limits.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to elections; modifying time limit  
2 requirements for filing campaign reports as specified; and  
3 providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 22-25-106(a)(i), (b)(i) and (h)(ii),  
8 22-25-107(b) and 22-25-108(b) are amended to read:

10 **22-25-106. Filing of campaign reports.**

11

12 (a) Except as otherwise provided in subsections (g)  
13 and (j) of this section and in addition to other statements  
14 required by this subsection:

15

1           (i) Every candidate shall file a fully itemized  
2 statement of contributions ~~at least seven (7)~~ thirty (30)  
3 days before any primary, general or special election with  
4 information required by this subsection current ~~to any day~~  
5 ~~from the eighth day up to the fourteenth day before the~~  
6 ~~election~~ up to forty-eight (48) hours prior to filing the  
7 statement;

8  
9           (b) Reports of itemized statements of contributions  
10 and statements of contributions and expenditures, and  
11 statements of termination shall be made with the  
12 appropriate filing officers specified under W.S. 22-25-107  
13 and in accordance with the following:

14  
15           (i) Except as otherwise provided in this  
16 section, any political action committee, candidate's  
17 campaign committee, or any political action committee  
18 formed under the law of another state that contributes to a  
19 Wyoming political action committee or to a candidate's  
20 campaign committee, any organization making an independent  
21 expenditure under W.S. 22-25-102(k), and any other  
22 organization supporting or opposing any ballot proposition  
23 which expends any funds in any primary, general or special

1 election shall file an itemized statement of contributions  
2 ~~at least seven (7)~~ thirty (30) days before the election  
3 current ~~to any day from the eighth day up to the fourteenth~~  
4 ~~day before the election~~ up to forty-eight (48) hours prior  
5 to filing the statement and shall also file a statement of  
6 contributions and expenditures within ten (10) days after a  
7 primary, general or special election;

8  
9 (h) In addition to any other report required by this  
10 section, an organization required by W.S. 22-25-110(c) to  
11 report expenditures shall report as follows:

12  
13 (ii) The report shall be filed ~~at least seven~~  
14 ~~(7)~~ thirty (30) days before the next primary, general or  
15 special election with information current ~~to any day from~~  
16 ~~the eighth day up to the fourteenth day before the election~~  
17 up to forty-eight (48) hours prior to filing the statement;

19 **22-25-107. Where statements to be filed.**

20  
21 (b) Statements required to be filed ~~at least seven~~  
22 ~~(7)~~ thirty (30) days before any primary, general or special  
23 election and statements required to be filed after any

1 primary, general or special election shall be filed  
2 electronically.

3

4 **22-25-108. Failure of candidate or committee to file**  
5 **statement.**

6

7 (b) A candidate who fails to file the statement of  
8 contributions required by the ~~seventh~~thirtieth day before  
9 the election shall have his name printed on a list drafted  
10 by the appropriate filing office specified under W.S.  
11 22-25-107. The list shall immediately be posted in the  
12 filing office and made available to the public.

14 **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon  
15 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law  
16 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming  
17 Constitution.
