Emergency financial managers' powers.

- 1 A JOINT RESOLUTION expressing disapproval of Michigan's
- 2 Local Government and School District Fiscal Accountability
- 3 Act and supporting a referendum for the repeal of that act.

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- 5 WHEREAS, the Legislature of the State of Michigan enacted
- 6 Public Act 4 of 2011, the Local Government and School
- 7 District Fiscal Accountability Act; and

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- 9 WHEREAS, Public Act 4 is purportedly "an act to safequard
- 10 and assure the fiscal accountability of units of local
- 11 government"; and

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- 13 WHEREAS, Public Act 4 was effective March 16, 2011 and
- 14 vastly expanded the powers granted to emergency financial

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15 managers under state law; and

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- 1 WHEREAS, Public Act 4 authorizes the governor to
- 2 unilaterally declare a financial emergency in any unit of
- 3 local government, including school districts; and

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- 5 WHEREAS, Public Act 4 also authorized the Michigan state
- 6 treasurer to appoint emergency financial managers; and

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- 8 WHEREAS, Public Act 4 gives emergency financial managers
- 9 broad and complete authority in the designated local
- 10 government jurisdiction, without transparency or
- 11 accountability, allowing the managers to sell public
- 12 property, enter into contracts, void all or selected
- 13 contracts, remove elected officials from office, dissolve
- 14 political structures such as councils and commissions, void
- 15 collective bargaining agreements, merge services and
- 16 political entities, borrow money on the public purse and
- 17 other dictatorial powers without seeking authority or
- 18 approval from any elected body, from the affected persons
- 19 or from the electorate; and

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- 21 WHEREAS, Public Act 4 conflicts in a most profound way with
- 22 deeply held democratic principles on which our nation and
- 23 our state were founded, and on which the people rely for
- 24 the security of their lives, liberty and property; and

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- 2 WHEREAS, Michigan's emergency manager law is one of the
- 3 most draconian of its kind in the United States, giving
- 4 emergency financial managers virtually dictatorial powers;
- 5 and

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- 7 WHEREAS, emergency financial managers are currently in
- 8 control of the cities of Flint, Benton Harbor, Ecorse and
- 9 Pontiac, as well as in the Detroit Public Schools, and the
- 10 Highland Park School District and the city of Detroit are
- 11 being reviewed for appointment of emergency financial
- 12 managers; and

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- 14 WHEREAS, it is inconsistent with American values to force
- 15 local governments to submit to a politically appointed
- 16 manager with vast powers over the public purse, property,
- 17 services, elected officials and structure of the local
- 18 government; and

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- 20 WHEREAS, a referendum is currently under way in Michigan to
- 21 repeal Public Act 4.

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- 23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE
- 24 LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:

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2 **Section 1.** The Legislature of the State of Wyoming 3 supports the referendum and the repeal of Public Act 4 of

4 2011.

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Section 2. The Legislature of the State of Wyoming
urges local elected officials, elected State
representatives and senators, and the people of the State
of Michigan to support the repeal of the "Local Government"

10 and School District Fiscal Accountability Act."

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Section 3. That the Secretary of State of Wyoming transmit copies of this resolution to the Legislature of the State of Michigan, the City of Detroit and the members of the Wyoming and Michigan congressional delegations.
