- 13 next general election for approval or rejection to become
- 14 valid as a part of the Constitution if ratified by a
- 15 majority of the electors at the election:

2	Article 15, Section 15. State tax for support of
3	public schools.

5	(a) For the support of the public schools in the
6	state there may be levied each year a state tax not
7	exceeding twelve mills on the dollar of the assessed
8	valuation of the property in the state.

L O	(b) For the construction and maintenance of public
L1	school facilities in the state there may be levied each
L2	year a state tax not exceeding six (6) mills on the dollar
L3	of the assessed valuation of the property in the state.

L 5	Section 2. That the Secretary of State shall endorse
L 6	the following statement on the proposed amendment:

L 8	The adoption of this amendment would authorize a tax of up
L 9	to six (6) mills on property in the state which would be
20	used only for the construction and maintenance of public
21	school facilities in Wyoming.
