A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to criminal procedure; authorizing release
2 of criminal history record information of military members
3 as specified; requiring submission for fingerprinting of
4 military members as specified; and providing for an
5 effective date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9 **Section 1.** W.S. 7-19-106(a)(xv) and 7-19-201(a)(viii)
10 are amended to read:

11

12 **7-19-106. Access to, and dissemination of,**
13 **information.**

1 (a) Criminal history record information shall be
2 disseminated by criminal justice agencies in this state,
3 whether directly or through any intermediary, only to:
4

5 (xv) The military department for purposes of
6 obtaining criminal history record information on
7 prospective employees, ~~or~~ volunteers or military members
8 serving in active duty or in the Wyoming national guard.
9 The dissemination of criminal history record information
10 authorized by this paragraph shall only occur if required
11 by the department for a position with the department,
12 training decisions, deployability, mobilization or security
13 clearance;

15 **7-19-201. State or national criminal history record**
16 **information.**

18 (a) The following persons shall be required to submit
19 to fingerprinting in order to obtain state and national
20 criminal history record information:
21

22 (viii) Prospective employees of or volunteers
23 with the Wyoming military department or active duty or

1 Wyoming national guard military members if the department
2 requires ~~prospective employees or volunteers, or both, to~~
3 ~~submit to fingerprinting in order to obtain~~ state and
4 national criminal history record information as a condition
5 for a position with the department, training decisions,
6 deployability, mobilization or security clearance;

8 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2018.
