A BILL

For

1 AN ACT relating to the Wyoming Controlled Substances Act;
2 adding specified controlled substances to schedule I of the
3 act; authorizing additional positions; providing an
4 appropriation; and providing for an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 35-7-1014(d) by creating a new
9 paragraph (xxxv) is amended to read:

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11 **35-7-1014. Substances included in Schedule I.**

12

13 (d) *Hallucinogenic substances.* - Unless specifically
14 excepted or unless listed in another schedule, any
15 material, compound, mixture or preparation which contains
16 any quantity of the following hallucinogenic substances,

1 their salts, isomers and salts of isomers whenever the
2 existence of these salts, isomers and salts of isomers is
3 possible within the specific chemical designation (for
4 purposes of this paragraph only, the term "isomer" includes
5 the optical, position and geometric isomers):

7 (xxxv) Synthetic cannabinoids as follows:

9 (A) (6aR,10aR)-9-(hydroxymethyl)-6,6-

10 dimethyl-3-(2-methyloctan-2-yl)-6a,7,10,10a-

11 tetrahydrobenzo[c]chromen-1-ol; some trade or other names:

12 HU-210;

14 (B) Dexanabinol, (6aS,10aS)-9-

15 (hydroxymethyl)-6,6-dimethyl-3-(2-methyloctan-2-yl)-

16 6a,7,10,10a-tetrahydrobenzo[c]chromen-1-ol; some trade or

17 other names: HU-211;

19 (C) Any compound structurally derived from

20 3-(1-naphthoyl)indole, 1H-indol-3-yl-(1-naphthyl)methane, 3-

21 (1-naphthoyl)pyrrole or 3-(phenylacetyl)indole by

22 substitution at the nitrogen atom of the indole or pyrrole

23 ring by alkyl, alkenyl, cycloalkylmethyl, cycloalkylethyl,

24 or 2-(4-morpholinyl)ethyl, whether or not further

1 substituted in the indole ring to any extent, and whether
2 or not substituted in the naphthyl or phenyl ring to any
3 extent; some trade or other names: JWH class compounds;

5 (D) 2-[(1R,3S)-3-hydroxycyclohexyl]-5-(2-
6 methyloctan-2-yl)phenol); some trade or other names: CP
7 47,497.

9 **Section 2.**

10
11 (a) The attorney general is authorized an additional
12 two (2) full-time forensic analyst positions to implement
13 this act. One position is authorized to begin July 1, 2011
14 and a second position is authorized to begin January 1,
15 2012.

16
17 (b) There is appropriated one hundred thirteen
18 thousand four hundred seventy-two dollars (\$113,472.00)
19 from the general fund to the attorney general. This
20 appropriation shall be for the period beginning with the
21 effective date of this act and ending June 30, 2012. This
22 appropriation shall only be expended for the purposes of
23 this act. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, this
24 appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for any

1 other purpose and any unexpended, unobligated funds
2 remaining from this appropriation shall revert as provided
3 by law on June 30, 2012. The additional positions and the
4 appropriation for the additional positions shall be
5 included in the attorney general's 2013-2014 standard
6 budget request.

7

8 **Section 3.** This act is effective July 1, 2011.
