W.S. 22-1-102(a)(xxiii)(F)(IV), 22-5-212 and 22-5-214 are amended to read: 8 9 10 22-1-102. Definitions. 11 12 (a) The definitions contained in this chapter apply to 13 words and phrases used in this Election Code and govern the 14 construction of those words and phrases unless they are

As 1 2 used in this Election Code: 3 4 (xxiii) "Poll list" is the list of registered voters as compiled by the clerk for use by election judges at 5 the polls. The poll list shall: 6 7 8 (F) Provide for the notation of: 9 10 (IV) For general elections, electors 11 who change political party affiliation at the polls. 12 13 22-5-212. When declaration of party affiliation 14 required. 15 16 An elector requesting a major party ballot must declare his 17 party affiliation, or sign an application for change of affiliation, in accordance with W.S. 22-5-214, before he may 18 19 receive a party ballot. An elector may vote only the 20 nonpartisan ballot and if so, is not required to declare his party affiliation. Requesting a partisan primary election 21 ballot constitutes a declaration of party affiliation. A 22 change in declaration of party affiliation shall conform to 23

1 W.S. 22-5-214 and be entered on the poll list by the election 2 judge. 3 4 22-5-214. Change in party affiliation. 5 Except as otherwise provided in this section, an elector may 6 7 change his party affiliation by completing an application 8 signed before a notarial officer or election official, and 9 filing it with the county clerk not less than fourteen (14) 10 days before the primary election or at the polls on the day 11 of the primary or general election, or when requesting an 12 absentee ballot. No elector may change party affiliation 13 between the period of time beginning two (2) weeks before the first day absentee ballots may be distributed under W.S. 14 22-9-107 through the day of the primary election. 15 16 17 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2019. 18 19 (END)
